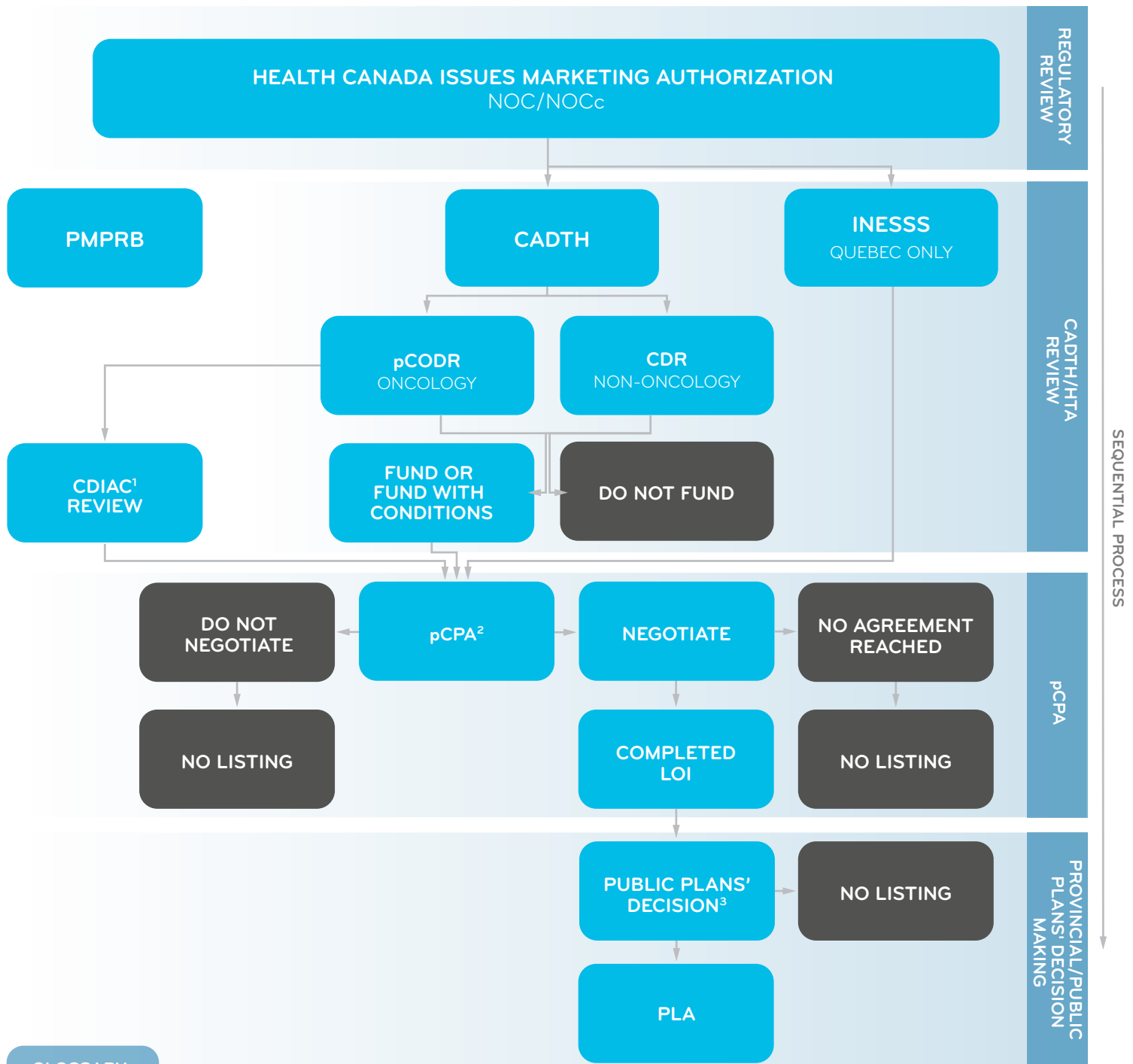


Canadian Drug Review and Public Reimbursement Process - An Overview*



GLOSSARY

CDIAC¹: Cancer Drug Implementation Advisory Committee. A new process since May 2016 - process and recommendation criteria not transparent.

CDR: Common Drug Review

HTA: Health Technology Assessment

INESSS: Institut national d'excellence en santé et en services sociaux

LOI: Letter of Intent

NOC: Notice of Compliance

NOCc: Notice of Compliance (conditional)

pCODR: pan-Canadian Oncology Drug Review

pCPA²: The pan-Canadian Pharmaceutical Alliance informs the manufacturers regarding the lead jurisdictions if there is an intent to negotiate.

PLA: Product Listing Agreement

PUBLIC PLANS' DECISION³: Provinces/public plans make their own final decision.

PMPRB: Patented Medicine Prices Review Board is the government agency which regulates pricing of patented drugs.
